PROCEDURE OF APPLYING FOR DISCRIPANCY & REVALUATION OF ASSESSED ANSWER BOOKS (AAB)

Students who desire to apply for and revaluation should follow below procedure to apply..
Steps:-

1. Login to software with valid email id.
2. Click on Result Verification Tab.
3. Select Semester.
4. Select courses for Revaluation , Discrepancy .
5. Select any one option from.
 1. Discrepancy: - if student have any doubts in result.
 2. Revaluation: - For only Revaluation of assessed answer book.
6. Pay Total amount by SBI collect / DD / Cash in T.I. office.
7. Enter the Details of Payment.
8. Submit form and Take a Print.
9. Submit Print to Exam Department along with Receipt.

- Note: - 1. Revaluation Fee = 50 Rs / Course.
2. Discrepancy Fee = Nil

Fees can be change time too time as per the notice from the institute head.

PROCEDURE FOR REASSESSMENT OF ANSWER BOOKS

- i. The Exam cell (shall appoint the examiners subject wise of the concerned course to reassess recommended cases. He shall not be the original valuer or the moderator).
- ii. In case such teacher with requisite teaching experience is not available, Exam Cell shall be competent to nominate a retired teacher or any other expert in the course.
- iii. The Exam cell shall communicate the revised marks to the applicant examinee through a suitable notification within the dates prescribed by the Institute.
- iv. The decision of the Institute shall be binding on the examinee.
- v. The revised marks will not confer any right upon the examinees for admission to the next higher class in the current academic year, if the schedule of admissions to the higher class does not so permit.
- vi. The revised statement of marks shall be given to the examinee only on surrendering his original statement of marks to the Exam cell.
- vii. The revision of marks accrued to the applicant examinee shall be counted towards award of merit, medals and prizes, where applicable.
